

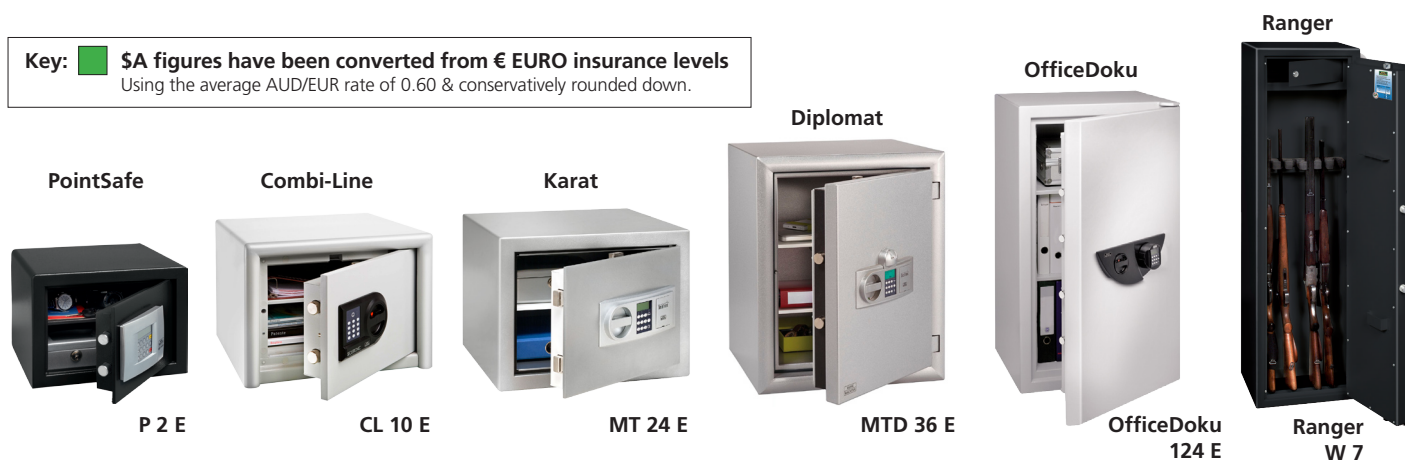

### Insurance cover

This rating indicates up to which value cash and valuables will be covered by the insurance company when they are stored inside a safe. Depending on the security measures taken insurance companies may diverge from the insurance cover value.

Advice: Always contact your insurance company whether they agree with the recommended insurance cover for your safe. Several environmental circumstances may lower the value, but can also increase it!

Since March 2005 the new European norm EN 14 450 is valid. This norm has especially been developed to rate frequently bought safes - particularly for daily use and storage of valuables. The anchoring of the safe either to the floor or to the wall is required.

In order to classify the quality of a safe the producer attaches a label at the inner side of the door. Like this you can see that the safe has been produced under supervised circumstances and has been tested according to the indicated resistance grade.



The EN standards that the BURG-WÄCHTER Safes are graded to, are typically either equivalent to the AS/NZS standards or are recognised by insurance companies in Australia & New Zealand to the same published guidelines.

BURG-WÄCHTER safes correspond to the highest technical standard and are internationally acknowledged. The BURG-WÄCHTER safe series KARAT, DIPLOMAT, OFFICE and ROYAL fulfil the requirements of the European norms EN-1143-1 and/or EN 1047-1. This is confirmed by the certificates issued through the ECB•S, the European Certification Board • Security Systems (certification office according to EN 45011). The ECB•S certification contains a regular and unannounced control of several production facilities: This guarantees a high and constant quality level.
